Re: Hurricane Harvey – Update No. 2

Dear Valued Customer,

This correspondence is provided as an update to the previous letters on the referenced matter as it relates to the Formosa Plastics Corporation, Texas – Point Comfort site.

At this time the return of employees to the site has been limited due to ongoing weather and safety issues. Both rail and truck transportation companies have suspended service to the plant and continue to assess the situation to determine when operations can safely resume. The embargo for rail continues to be in place for shipments to Houston and the surrounding areas. Further, a raw material supplier of ethane and propane has declared force majeure and is assessing the current status of its supply.

It is anticipated that a supply plan will be available no later than August 31, 2017.
